1. Council resolved to accept the Shared Charter Engagement Forum Terms of Reference.
2. Council resolved to discuss the fence at the cemetery and the location of any fence posts with Cllr. Evans on her return from holiday.
3. Council resolved that the Clerk will contact RCT Highways about road signs on the road leading to and from the cemetery.
4. Council resolved that Cllr. Andrew Tobin will speak to Dan Dudley about the cemetery gates as they need repair and paint. Also, to ask about a price for a Rhigos Cemetery sign to go onto the gate.
5. Council resolved to co-opt Elisha Jones onto the Community Council and the Clerk will contact her to inform her.
