Decisions

1. Council resolved that Cllr. Smith will obtain quote for cutting the trees and hedge in the cemetery.
2. Council resolved that Cllr. O Morgan send the information for the Ombudsman letter to the Clerk as soon as possible and to meet with the Clerk to look at the refuse collection details and contract.
3. Council resolved to retain the current charges for the allotments, community centre and cemetery.
4. Council resolved that Cllr. M Evans contact the plumber to arrange the installation of an additional sink basin in the kitchen and “caution hot water” signage.
5. Council resolved that Cllr. Oliver will find out which part of the Penderyn School Estyn Report they want published.
6. Council resolved that the Clerk will pay the grant to Rhigos Rugby Club.
7. Council resolved that the Clerk purchase cleaning materials, gorilla tape and mounting tape for the community centre and also agreed the purchase of a mop and bucket, a battery and fire sign, a fire alarm key and a caution wet floor sign. Cllr. M. Smith agreed to put up the battery sign and to look at the toilet flush on the gents.

8. Council resolved that the Clerk will contact Walters Group with the what3words coordinates for the placement of the requested benches.

9. Council resolved that the Clerk will contact Dean RCTCBC to order four 4G cameras and to set up a direct debit payment for the monthly charge.

10. Council resolved that the Clerk will contact the electrician to chase up the metal consumer unit and inform him that the front light is not coming on.

11. Council resolved that the Clerk will meet with Cllr. Morgan to look at the Veolia contract and that the new caretaker will take on the cemetery bins along with the community centre.

12. Council resolved that the Clerk will meet with the new caretaker for an induction session and arrange that she call in to the coffee morning.
