

## **Rhigos Report- May**

### **Police**

Recently spoke with our PCSOs on residents' concerns with late-night activity on Parish Road. PCSOs are going to carry out more foot patrols of the area.

An electric motorbike was seized following a boy riding down on the road from Rhigos and around Aberdare town.

### **Streetcare**

Next black bag waste collection dates are **Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> April** and **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June**.

Put in request for a new dog fouling bin for along Cwm Hwnt, after the Rhigos Rugby Club.

Requested dog fouling patrols for Rhigos- Heol Esgyn, Heol Gwranfryn and outside the Premier Shop opposite Min Afon.

Reported a broken streetlight at Hirwaun Industrial Estate roundabout.

Reported the pavements and road that need clearing along Rhigos Road, from Rhigos roundabout up to the H P Price business.

Contacted local homecare services asking them to remind staff not to dump health-related waste on roads/pavements.

### **Highways**

An RCT officer has been invited to Rhigos to discuss yellow line requests and speeds- awaiting confirmation date.

Reported dumped rubble along Rhigos Road.

Following the report of work bollards being abandoned along Rhigos Road, RCT responded- "The bollards and signs have not been abandoned there is an excavation in the verge, and these barriers should be around that excavation. I have contacted National Grid and asked them to return to site and put the barriers up correctly. National Grid are laying a cable along Rhigos Road to the roundabout, then up Rhigos Mountain Road to their sub station and also a little way down Fifth Avenue."

RCT have confirmed Longmeade Park is on the list for consideration in any future unadopted roads programme.

Shared concerns with the pavement leading to Rhigos Rugby Club.

**Public buses**

We posted on social media about the interest of having a new bus stop or two along Heol Esgyn and Heol Gwrangfryn. If there are any residents who would be willing to have one placed outside their property, please let us know.

Asked RCT about the possibility of sides being added to the bus stop opposite Heol-y-Graig junction (Rhigos Road).

**Trees**

RCT have responded to previous tree complaints on Glynneath Bank- "We currently have tree work being undertaken to complete the previously inspected highway. On completion, next week we will proceed with any enforcement on land owners of dead and dangerous trees which poses a risk to the public highway."
