1. Council resolved to accept the accounts for the year 2025-2026 and the Clerk will now publish the notice to view and reimburse the internal auditor.
2. Council resolved that Cllr. Smith liaise with Cllr. Morgan about the trees at the cemetery in order to have them cut back.
3. Council resolved that the Clerk obtain estimates for the work on the paths around the Community Centre.
4. Council resolved that the Clerk contact SSE and ask to be billed monthly. Also to check if the account is out of contract and can be moved to another account.
5. Council resolved to purchase the plants for the pots at the entrance and exit of the village. Clerk to reimburse Cllr Wagner.
